



Holbæk Water Works

Supplying 1,700,000 m³ water to 23,000 People

Denmark

Plant Description

The drinking water system of Holbæk dates all the way back to 1890. It has been modernized in several stages most lately with a major extension in 1993. The water works serves approximately 23,000 inhabitants, and supplies 1,700,000 m³ of water annually. The system encompasses two plants, each having a capacity of 200 m³/hr. The water is distributed through approximately 500 km of transmission pipeline.



Owner

Holbæk municipality owns the water works.

IGSS Application

The IGSS application serves the water works having a central server with two main workstations. The two water works can be controlled centrally as well as locally. The system is a 1,000 object IGSS system.

IGSS Implementation

The IGSS application has been configured and installed by RAMBØLL, Vand og Miljø.
